

With regards to becoming a National Tutor for the NPMQ you will find some information regarding the person specification and job description that you may find useful.

As you will see from the person specification, potential Tutors are required to hold the National Pool Management Qualification. Once potential Tutors have been interviewed, selected and passed the NPMQ they will be required to attend a **four day** Train the Tutors course. This course has been designed to ensure that the NPMQ is delivered in a way that maintains the integrity of the NPMQ.

We will commence the second round of recruitment in the early part of 2010 and to that end, to be involved in this process potential Tutors are encouraged to forward their Curriculum Vitae and Covering Letter to Martin Symcox at their earliest convenience at [npmq@iql.org.uk](mailto:npmq@iql.org.uk) The course dates and locations for next year will be available shortly. The course fee to become a National Tutor for the NPMQ is £1800. The earning potential for a National Tutor is approximately £1200 per course plus expenses (limited to £75 per day).
